City Council Regular Meeting Minutes
Monday, October 3, 2022

The Auburn City Council met in regular session at 7:00 pm on Monday, October 3, 2022, in the council chambers of Auburn City Hall.

Previous Meeting Minutes

Approval of September 19, 2022, meeting minutes reviewed. Council Member Stewart motioned to approve meeting minutes. Council Member Randles seconded the motion. Motion approved Unanimous.

Question of Bills

Detailed report of payment of invoices and checks included in meeting packet for all to review. Council Member Arpin motioned approve accounts payable ledger of \$24,322.43 including Payroll. Council Member Stewart seconded the motion. Motion approved Unanimous.

Citizens Forum

Mark Benaka asked if pools must have fence in city limits. Attorney Luckman reviewed city code for nuisance.

City Engineer Pat Cox

Midwest construction of North building sewer service discussed. City Engineer Cox located pressure pumps from Haynes equipment company expecting to receive additional stock in November at the price of \$16,000-\$20,000 per pump. Recommends 2 duplex pumps. Indicated landowner feels the city should pay for the electricity to run pumps. Price of pumps does not include any other labor or equipment. A \$5,000 deposit per pump is required for pre-order.

Council Member Stewart motioned to approve purchase of 2 pumps for a deposit of \$5,000 each with balance due paid upon delivery. Council Member Potter seconded motion. Motion approved Unanimous.
